

AVAILABILITY

This rate is available to consumers with three-phase primary services that require more than 50 kVA of transformer capacity who are taking service at voltage of 14,400 and above and in excess of 750 kVA, furnishing their own transformer and substation equipment, and receiving delivery of electricity at primary voltage metering.

NEC shall have the right to approve of transformers and substation equipment furnished by the consumer under this type of service.

Demand/TOU metering must be installed to record kVa demand and kWh usage during the hours specified below. Consumers may change to or from the TOU Rate only once during a twelve (12) month period.

DESCRIPTION

This rate has three parts: a monthly service availability charge, a demand charge for the highest amount of demand (kVa) varied by time-of-use in a 15-minute period for the month, and an energy charge for the energy (kWh) used during the month.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Three-phase, over 50 kVA transformer capacity, alternating current, 60 cycles, at available primary voltages.

TIME PERIODS

For this rate schedule, On-Peak hours shall be 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. every day. Off-Peak hours shall be all other times.
