DIRECT ACCESS SERVICE

*Note: The Retail Electric Competition Rules are on hold and no Electric Service Provider has been authorized by the Arizona Corporation Commission to provide competitive electric service in NEC's service territory.*

The following basic Service Details apply to Direct Access Service:

- 1) Direct Access Consumers who purchase available electric services from a supplier other than NEC may take service under the unbundled components of the rate schedule set forth on this Schedule I-C applicable to the Direct Access Customer's class of service, for the services received from NEC.
- 2) Direct Access Consumers are bound by NEC's rules, policies and standards approved by the Arizona Corporation Commission to the extent not expressly inconsistent with the applicable Service Schedule. The rules, policies and standards provide details about how NEC serves its Consumers, and they have provisions and charges that may affect the Customer's bill (for example, service connection charges).
- 3) Direct Access Consumers and NEC must mutually agree, in a written contract, on the conditions under which direct access service will be made available.
