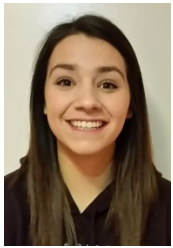
*LeCario Benashley – Alchesay HS*

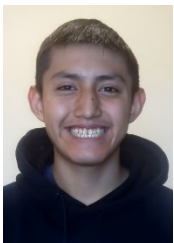
*Michael Carrejo – Reserve HS*
